

UW-Madison Undergraduate Certificate in Global Health Planning Sheet

Keep in mind:

- 1) You must complete at least 15 credits, earning a C or better in each course.
- 2) Many students do not get into the fall NS 203 or the spring core courses until their junior or senior years, though we encourage you to try earlier.
- 3) You must fit in a field experience before your planned graduation date. Start planning this early!
- 4) Admission to most field experiences requires that you have completed at least one core course.
- 5) You are eligible to declare using the program's online form once you have completed at least one core course (*completed*, not started!). Your GPA must also be greater than 2.0.
- 1. CORE COURSES Help you develop basic understanding of Global Health (6-9 credits). You must take NS203 and one other core course, but are encouraged to take all three, with 3rd counting as an elective.

2. FIELD EXPERIENCE – See what working in a global health context looks like. Can be done internationally or domestically for 1-4 credits. Must be approved by the program, must be done for credit.
